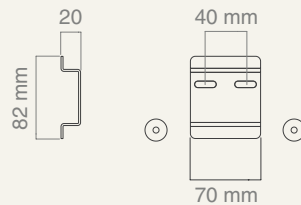

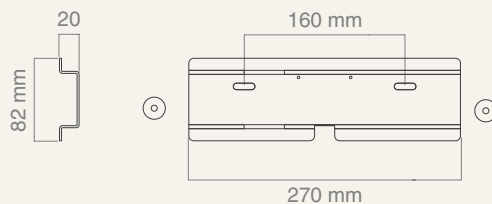

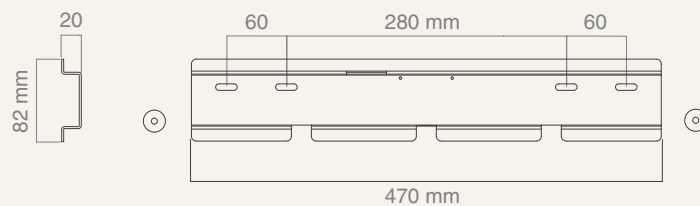
MOUNTING BAR 4000-200-BAR



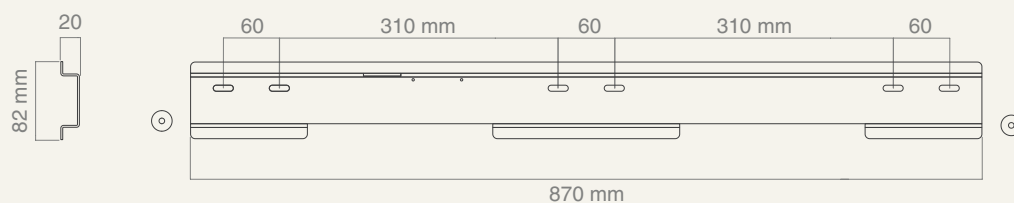
MOUNTING BAR 4000-400-BAR

MATERIAL: STAINLESS STEEL

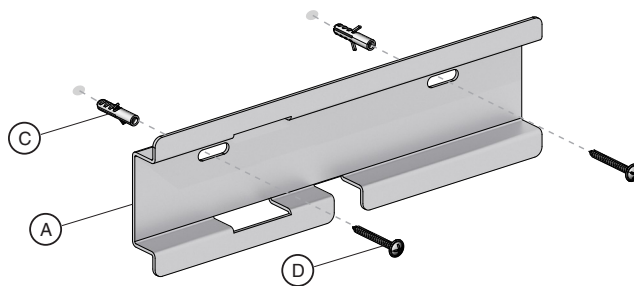
MOUNTING OF DISTANCE BAR

- 1 Use this Mounting Bar (A) to achieve the same distance from the wall, as your UNU Shelves with Backlight Bars.
Note: UNU Shelves are sold separately.

Determine and mark the positions for the screw holes where the Mounting Bar will be mounted on the wall.

Use an 8 mm drill bit to drill the marked holes.
Insert the Ø8x38 mm wall plugs (C) into the holes.

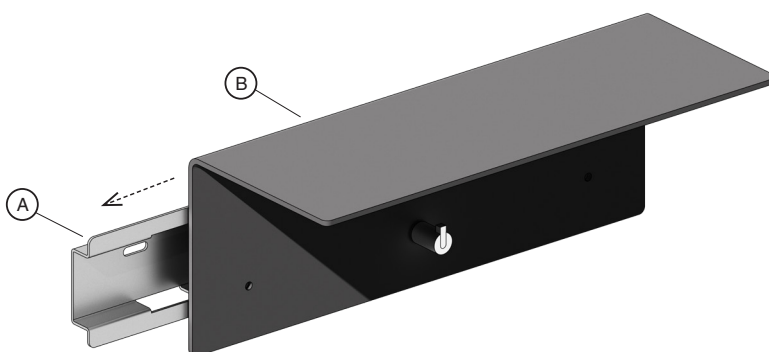
Secure the Mounting Bar (A) to the wall using the provided Ø5x40 mm screws (D). Use a Phillips screwdriver with a PH2 bit to tighten the screws.



- 2 Slide your UNU Shelf (B) onto the Mounting Bar (A).

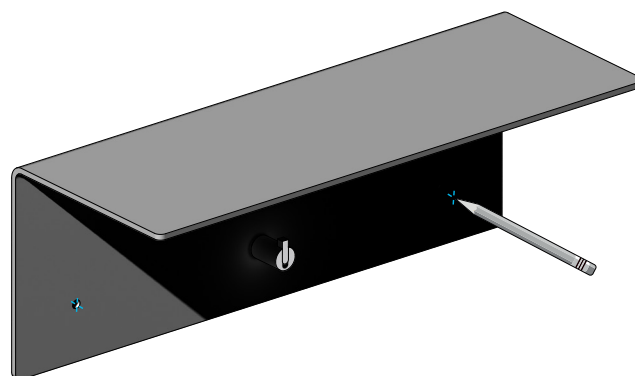
Note for UNU Coat Rack models:

Please continue with the following instructions specific to Coat Rack installation.

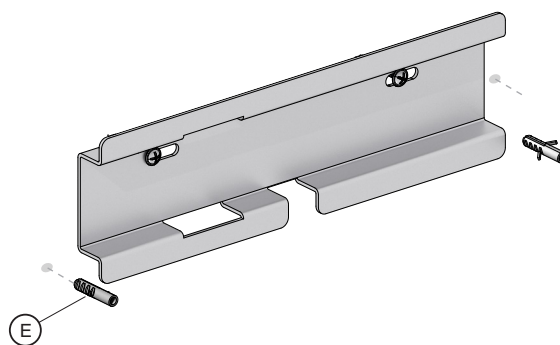


MOUNTING OF UNU COAT RACKS

- 3 Mark the placement of two screw holes as illustrated. Then slide the Coat Rack (B) off the Mounting Bar (A).

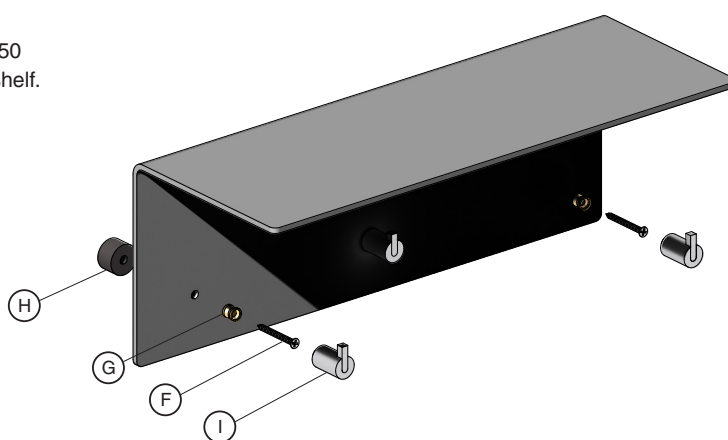


- 4 Drill the marked holes and insert the two Ø6x30 wall plugs (E). Then slide the Coat Rack (B) back on to the Mounting Bar (A).

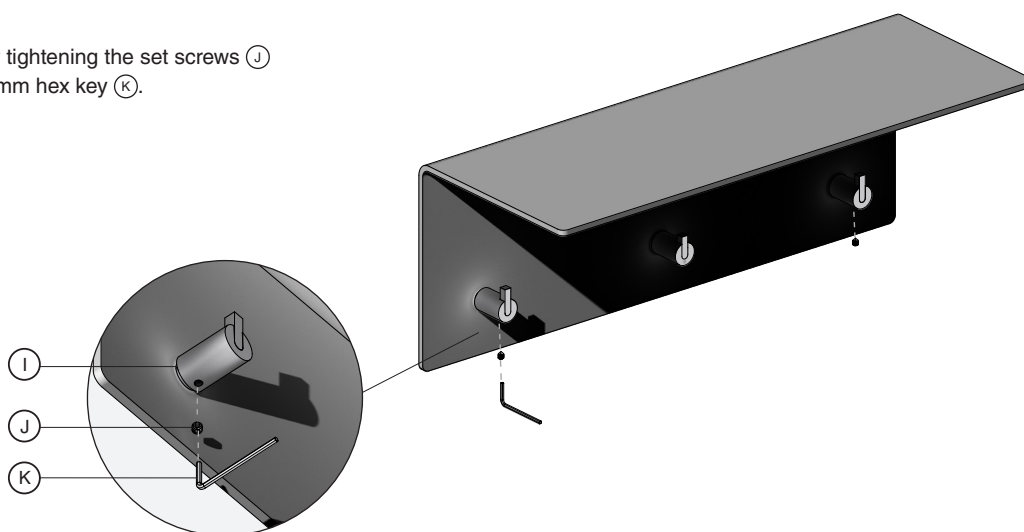


- 5 Secure the Coat Rack with the brass inserts (G) and Ø4x50 screws (F) and place the Plastic Spacers (H) behind the shelf.

Afterwards press the hooks (I) on the brass inserts.



- 6 Secure the hooks (I) by tightening the set screws (J) underneath, with the 2 mm hex key (K).



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Surfaces should be cleaned with a microfiber cloth, glass cleaner or other non abrasive and gentle agents.
