



MOUNTING




Mount the eight crossbars (B) by gently inserting them into the pre-made holes in the side frame (A), by using small rotational movements. For some finish models, you may need to apply a bit more force to fully insert the crossbars (B).



Mount the opposite side frame ⓒ onto the ends of the eight crossbars (B). This may also require small rotational movements.



Use the sixteen Ø4x10 mm screws (D) to fasten the eight crossbars to the two side frames. Tighten all the screws (D) with the 3 mm enclosed hex key (G).



Place the Shoe Rack in the desired position and mark the screw holes as illustrated, with a CC distance of either 600 or 1000 mm.

Drill the marked holes using a 8 mm drill bit and insert the enclosed Ø8x38 mm wall plugs (E).

Insert the Ø6x39 mm screws (F) with a Phillips screwdriver with bit PH3. Let the screw stick a bit out to place the Shoe Rack onto.



MOUNTING OF ADDITIONAL FEET

Additional feet can be purchased seperately for the Double Shoe Racks, so it can stand on the floor.

For mounting the feet onto the Shoe Rack simply press them onto the bottom the side frames (A) / (\bigcirc) as illustrated.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Surfaces should be cleaned with a microfiber cloth, glass cleaner or other non abrasive and gentle agents.

Never use solvents or aggressive household cleaners like bleach, acids (e.g. descalers) or ammonia-based bathroom cleaner to clean the product. Steel wool and hard brushes can permanently damage the surface of the steel.
